Here is a photograph of Ingrow West Station



It is one of the station on the *Keighley and Worth Valley Railway* .

Ingrow West station building has not been here very long. It was at another station in Lancashire called Foulridge.

Foulridge did not need a station building so it was pulled down and each stone was given a number. The stones were loaded onto a lorries and brought to Ingrow. They were put together like a jigsaw and the station was built up again at Ingrow.
